Joanne was previously a Legal Adviser to Family Magistrates across London for 3 years. Within this role Joanne: advised the family court on a broad range of family law matters regularly assisted and facilitated parties and representatives in reaching agreement sometimes on sensitive and sometimes legally complex matters put questions to witnesses in domestic abuse cases on behalf of the court where parties were prohibited from cross-examining each other reformulated questions from self-represented parties to ensure they were relevant and appropriate developed ability to prepare last minute cases and quickly identifying the relevant reading, key issues and advice that the court needed to be given presided upon FHDRA hearings in the Legal Adviser only court.

As a Legal Adviser, Joanne was instrumental in delivering training where she:

Joanne was also trained as a specialist in the Reciprocal Enforcement of Maintenance Orders and had the benefit of receiving continuous training from the Judicial College in all areas of family law.
